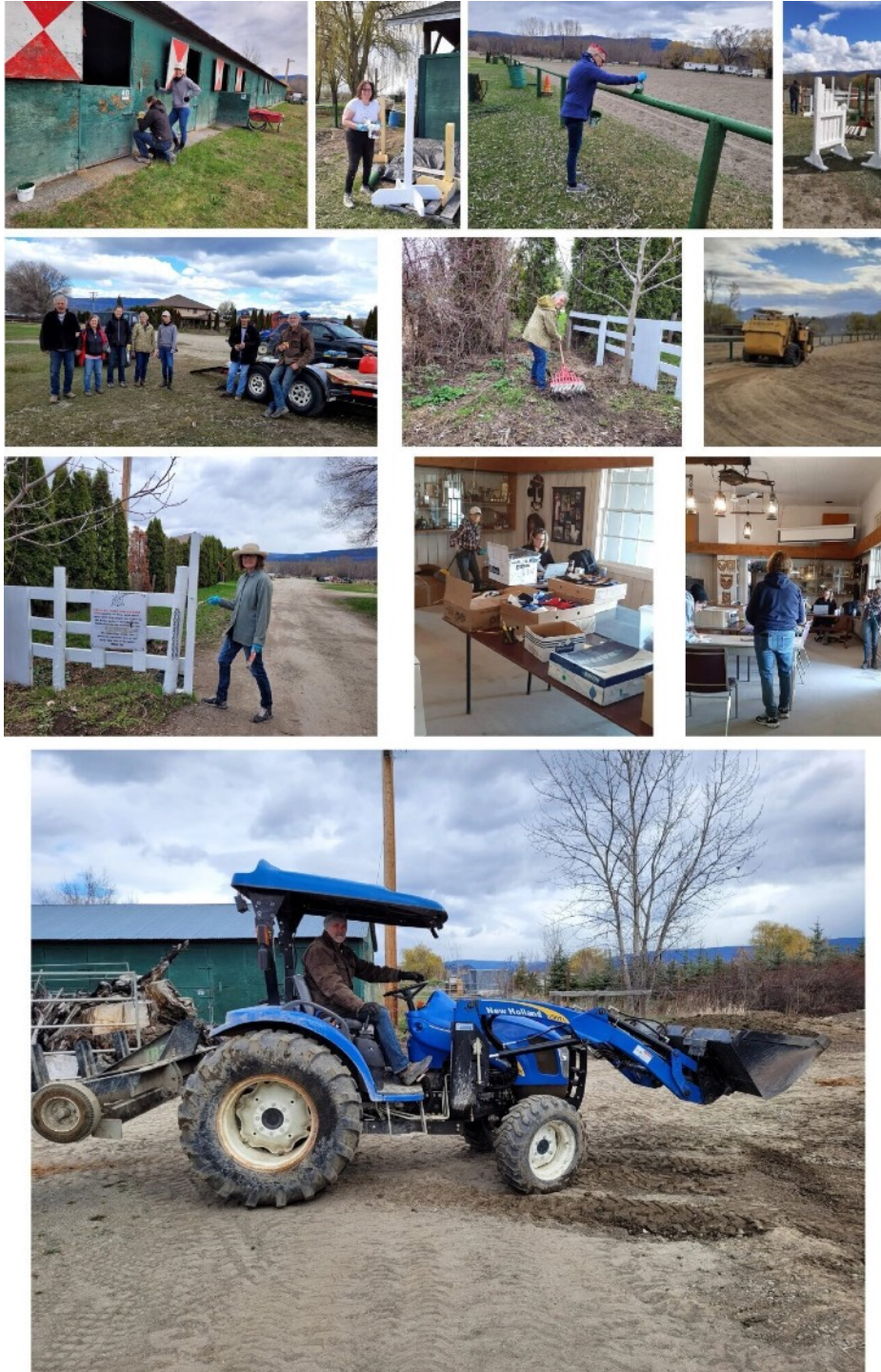




KRC Spring Cleaning Is Rocking, Raking, Repairing, and Painting!



Thank you to all the volunteers who have turned out at the work parties on April 2nd, 3rd and 10th. All that was accomplished could not have been done without all of you. It was so nice to see so many of those friendly faces that we that have all been missing.

Here is of some of what the volunteers accomplished:

- The painting of jumps, ring rails & the entrance fence is underway.
- The manure pile moved to back of the property.
- Posts around rings have been repaired.
- Wash rack prepped for the upcoming season.
- Stalls bedded for upcoming clinic.
- Stall maintenance and repairs are in progress.
- Two more steel wheelbarrows with solid tires donated.
- Tires & inner tubes replaced on the large red wheelbarrows.
- Dishwasher has been donated and installed.
- Ribbon and prize inventory updated.
- A burn permit allowed for the burning of branches, and leaves.
- Irrigation lines have been repaired and tested.
- Fire extinguishers are recharged, and emergency lights inspected.
- Rock screening has been completed in the Hunter and dressage rings.
